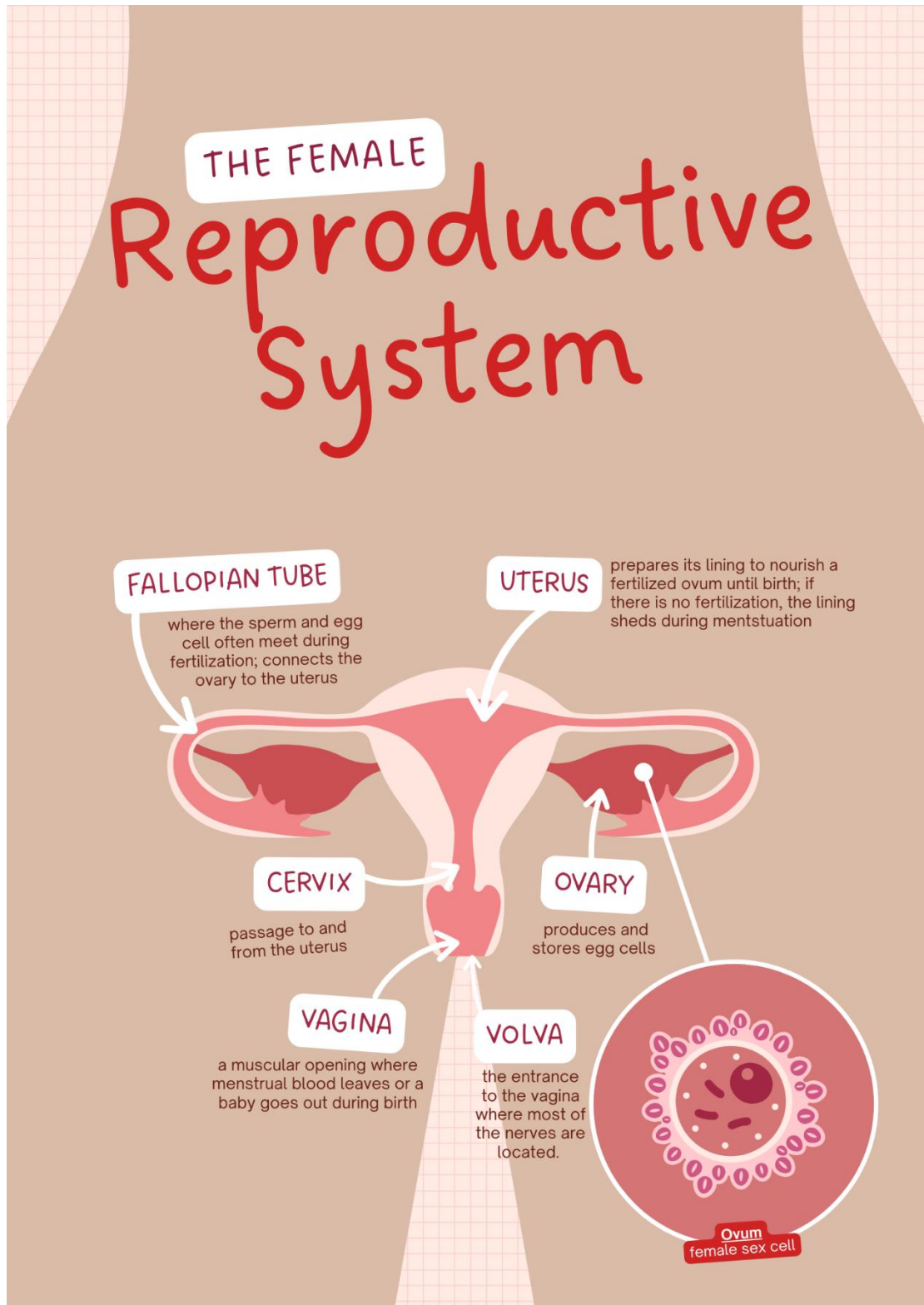


Answers:
